#### **Dance Day Preparation**

How to Get Ready for Class Quickly

Preparing for dance class can be a daunting task after school when schedules often feel rushed. With preparation, this process can actually be quick and organized, so we created a checklist for your family to follow:


- Have a designated "Dance Bag" where shoes, hair pins etc. are kept week-toweek to simplify (we recommend recycling an old backpack or other bag with a zipper closure to prevent loss).
- Pack the dance bag the night before with clean tights, leotard, water bottle and bun kit.
- Arrive 10-15 minutes early to change clothing and tidy your hair/ twist it into a bun before class begins once experienced, a bun can be done in the car!
- Return dance shoes and hair pins to the bag immediately after class to have them for next time!
- Do a trial run the week before classes begin (September 13<sup>th</sup>) to test how much assistance your dancer requires and how long the process will take for them know that each week it will before more familiar and more efficient!
