Q: What can we expect the day of the audition?

Students enrolled in at least one ballet class are invited to join us on Saturday 09/14 for our annual Nutcracker Auditions! Our Primary & Elementary age ballet students will learn one role within their class time, however, many dancers choose to audition for additional roles and enjoy more stage time on the big day! Additional roles do require additional rehearsals and those dates will be communicated as soon as possible once casting is completed. By learning a variety of characters and managing the rehearsal schedule in addition to regular dance classes and school your passionate young dancers will grow as people and as performers and it will surely be an inspiring gift to watch the story come to life on stage in December!

A: We approach our auditions from an educational standpoint. Dancers as young as five years old will be provided with age appropriate guidance on audition etiquette and presentation as they learn exciting movement combinations from a variety of roles in the ballet. Our goal is for each student to exit the audition with a sense of pride in themselves!

- Arrive fifteen minutes prior to your audition time to get your number & warm-up
- Bring a water bottle
- Audition Attire:

Females - Hair in a neat bun secured with bobby pins and hairnet, pink tights, solid color leotard, ballet shoes & pointe shoes (if on pointe -

wear pointe shoes into the studio & bring ballet shoes in hand)

Males - Fitted black shorts or tights with a white T-Shirt & black ballet shoes

 <u>Audition Cost of</u> \$25.00 per dancer or \$45 per family will be charged to your Studio Director account. A Performance fee of \$100 will be posted to your account once casting is finalized. Please see Our Student Handbook for additional information.

- Hand-Sewing Assistant (Small tucks/mending with needle and thread) 9:30-11:30, 11:30-1:30 or 1:30-2:30
- Seamstress on Sewing Machine 9:30-11:30, 11:30-1:30 or 1:30-2:30

One sewing machine can be provided, but if you're able to bring your own that would be incredibly helpful!

Our teachers arrive 10-15 minutes before their first class to prepare the studio but may be teaching another class prior to your child's; for this reason we ask that you remain with your child as they prepare their hair, put on their dance shoes, use the restroom and ready themselves prior to lining up with their teacher for class. In the event that students need to visit the restroom during their class, teachers will monitor their time out with a pass system. Please note that the security code recently changed and is posted inside our studio for families to reference (this should only be shared with members of our NESD&T community).

Lastly, if your dancer is a teenager who may be planning to leave the building during their break for any reason (ie: driving to Dunkin Donuts or even walking downstairs to pick up Thai Food from Udon) they are required to tell a staff member when they're leaving. In the event of an emergency, any student enrolled that day will need to be accounted for. We appreciate your support as we work together to remind the children of these safety protocols, ensuring a wonderful school year for all!
