Important Tuition and Auto-Pay Updates

As of August 1st, NESD&T will return to processing tuition and costume fees on the 1st of each month. One exception to this change will be the spring production Costume fee charges due on January 15th. Ballet students' Nutcracker Performance Fees will be posted to accounts following casting for October 1st payment. Performing Company members have already been informed that their costume fees will be due on August 1st (soloists and duo/trios) as well as September 1st (groups). If you have not already signed up for monthly auto-pay please update your CC or bank account info while registering on Studio Director and be sure to check the auto-pay box and take tuition payments off your to-do list!
